Harriet Peterson is a USDF fourth level certified instructor, a USDF silver medalist and an "r" dressage judge. As a dressage rider she has trained and competed quite a diverse variety of horses, winning numerous regional and national competitions including Bengt Ljungquist Championships and USDF horse of the year awards. She trained and rode her Selle Francais gelding Eckankar to Intermediare I before donating him to the VA Tech intercollegiate dressage team. In 2006 she won the USDF freestyle stakes class at Dressage in the Sandhills in Pinehurst NC on the Trakehner mare Copelia and the Bengt Ljungquist Memorial Finals USDF freestyle championship on the Friesian gelding Pier B who also was 2<sup>nd</sup> level horse of the year in Virginia. She also won 2<sup>nd</sup> level horse of the year in VA on Diane Stewart's horse Boomer (from Bozeman).

Before retiring from eventing in the late 80's she trained and rode the 1982 USCTA Mare of the Year and the 1987 National Preliminary Horse Trails champion.

In the years since moving from Billings to Virginia Harriet has added driving to her training interests and has been training horses to drive for pleasure and combined driving.

Harriet likes to divide her time between teaching, training, showing and judging. She lives with her husband Jim, who teaches creative writing at Randolph college and Dylan the Welsh Corgi in Lynchburg, VA.
